Users will understand the natural and cultural significance of the park.



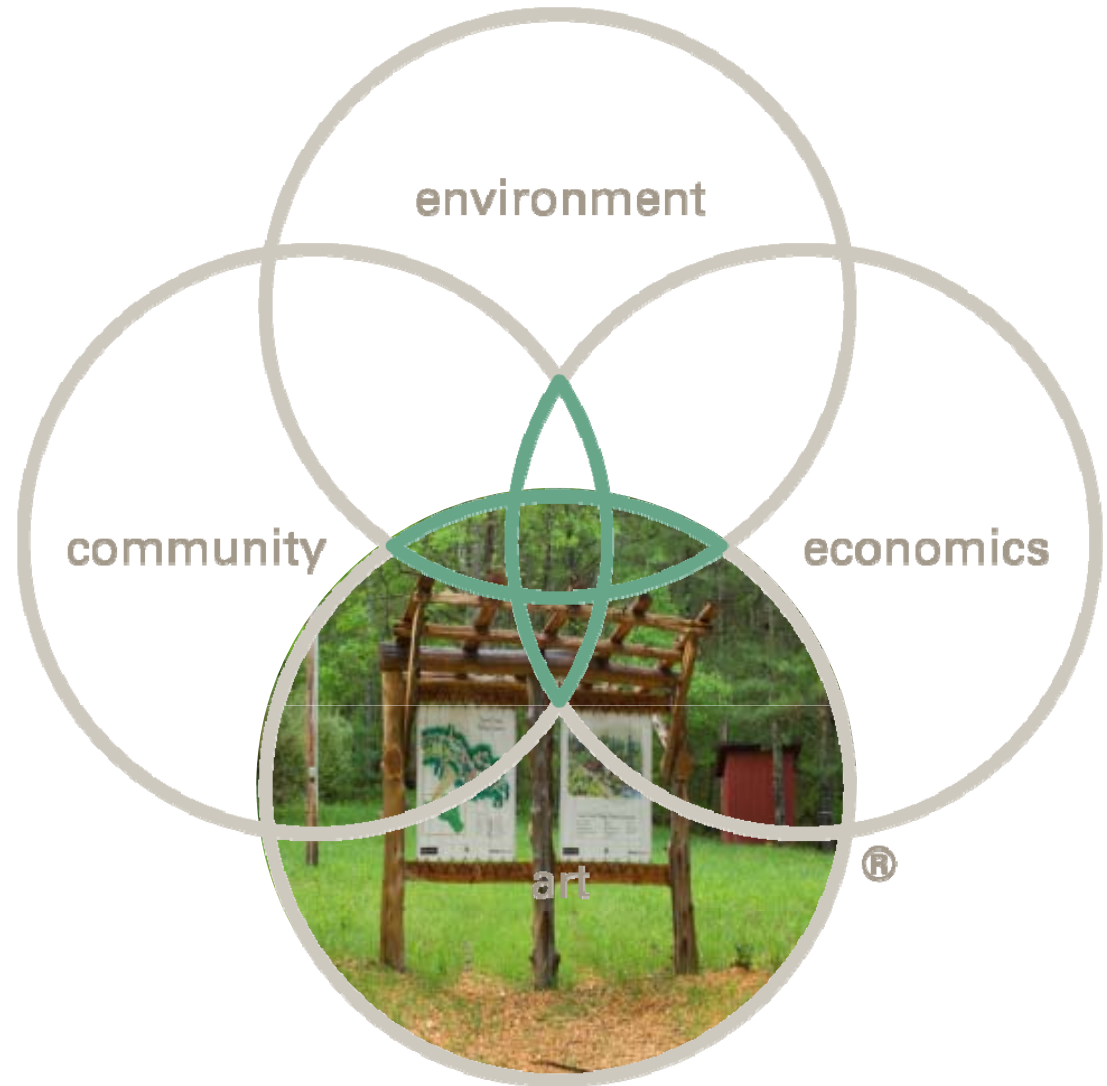
Economic Goals
